



Josef Dudek



Frederikshavn Kunstmuseum ejer en af de største exlibris-samlinger i verden og ser det som sin opgave gennem regelmæssige udstillinger at skabe interesse for denne knap så kendte men interessante del af den grafiske kunst.



Gennem godt 30 år viser vi derfor større og mindre udstillinger med exlibris fra museets samlinger, som præsenterer en bestemt kunstner eller kunstnere fra et land eller område. Ligeledes har mange udstillinger bestemte temaer eller motiver. I samarbejde med andre museer blev der skabt store udstillinger som f.eks. 'Europa og Tyren' og i de senere år har vi vist et af de mest interessante projekter, de internationale exlibris-biennaler fra Polen, nærmere betegnet fra middelalderborgen Malbork.

Med denne nye række af 'Portrait-Udstillinger' vil vi fremover præsentere exlibris af nogle af de bedste nulevende kunstnere fra mange



lande, for at vise kvaliteten og skønheden i det moderne grafisk udformede bogejermærke for derigennem at skabe interesse hos museets besøgende. Måske kan den ene eller anden føle sig fristet til at anskaffe sig et exlibris.

Det er dejligt, at det er lykkedes for museet at få kontakt med nogle af nutidens bedste kunstnere og derigennem få mulighed for at gennemføre denne udstillingsrække af internationalt format.

Das Frederikshavn Kunstmuseum besitzt eine der größten Exlibris-sammlungen der Welt und sieht es als seine Aufgabe, durch regelmäßige Ausstellungen das Publikum dem grafischen Bucheignerzeichen näher zu bringen.






The Frederikshavn Art Museum owns one of the largest bookplate collections in the world and considers it as its obligation to familiarize the general public with graphic bookplates by regular exhibitions.

Thus, for 30 years we have shown bookplates from our funds in larger or smaller exhibitions to present one or several artists of a country, or else certain topics or motifs. In cooperation with other museums, major exhibitions like 'Europa and the bull' came into being. Likewise, the museum regularly shows the exhibition of the International Biennial of the Bookplate from Malbork, Poland



In future we want to present the exlibris of contemporary artists with this new series of small 'Portrait Exhibitions' to make visitors aware of the quality, charm and beauty of the presentday graphic design of bookplates. Hopefully some will feel enticed to commission their own exlibris.

The museum succeeded in motivating a number of the best contemporary artists to cooperate and was thus able to call into life this series of exhibitions.

Josef Dudek


Født 1954 i byen Šumperk i det tidligere Tjekkoslovakiet. Han studerede i Olomouc ved Palckého Universitet, hvor professor Dušan Janoušek underviste ham i komposition. Han afsluttede studierne i 1976 - arbejdede herefter et par år på et børnehjem i Olomouc og i en skole.

I dag arbejder og bor han i Praha. Han underviser i tegning og grafik på en grafisk grundskole. Som kunstner beskæftiger han sig med fri grafik og exlibris. Han skaber også frimærker, messedesign og foto-kunst.

1997 fik han kontakt med den tjekkiske grafikkendere Václav Křupka, hvor han blev gjort interesseret i exlibris. Han fik også kontakt med en række betydelige personligheder på dette område. Et af hans første exlibris skabte han således til Klaus Rödel.

Josef Dudek påstår, at han er ret uordentlig og ikke interesseret i at tælle sine værker eller udstillinger. Der findes derfor ingen fortægnelse

over hans grafiske arbejder. Han mener dog at han har afholdt ca. 30 personlige udstillinger og deltaget i omrent 150 kollektive.

Josef Dudek

Josef Dudek ist 1954 in der Stadt Šumperk in der damaligen Tschechoslowakei geboren. Er studierte in der Stadt Olomouc auf der Palackého Universität. Sein Lehrer der Graphischen Komposition war Professor Dušan Janoušek. Er promovierte 1976. Danach arbeitete er ein paar Jahre im Kinderheim in Olomouc und auf einer Kunstgrundschule.

Jetzt lebt er und arbeitet in Prag. Er unterrichtet Zeichnen und Graphische Techniken auf einer Kunstgrundschule. In eigenem Schaffen macht er freie Graphik und Exlibris. Gelegentlich schafft er auch Briefmarken, Messerdesign, Fotografie und andere Fächer.

1997 lernte Josef Dudek den Förderer der tschechischen Graphik Václav Křupka kennen. Dieser regte ihn zum Exlibrisschaffen an und machte ihn mit bedeutenden Personen aus diesem Bereich bekannt. Eines der ersten Exlibris schuf Josef Dudek für Klaus Rödel.

Josef Dudek behauptet, dass er sehr unordentlich ist und dass er nicht mag, seine Werke und seine Ausstellungen zu zählen. Deshalb hat er keine komplette Liste seiner Graphiken. Bis heute gibt es etwa 30 Personalausstellungen sowie Teilnahme an ungefähr 150 Kollektivausstellungen.



We introduce:

Josef Dudek

Josef Dudek was born in 1954 in Šumperk (then in Czechoslovakia). He studied at the Palackého University, Olomouc. His teacher in graphic composition was Prof. Dušan Janoušek. In 1976 he took his doctorate. He then worked for several years in the children's home in Olomouc and at an art school.

He now lives and works in Prague. He teaches drawing and graphic techniques at an art school. His own work is devoted to free graphics and bookplates. Occasionally he also creates stamps, designs knives and goes in for photography and other subjects.

In 1997 Josef Dudek came to know the propagator of Czech graphics Václav Křupka who suggested he should create bookplates and introduced him to important persons in this field. One of his first bookplates he created for Klaus Rödel.


Claiming not to be very organised, Dudek does not like to count his works or exhibitions. So he has no complete list of his graphics. Till now there have been about 30 personal exhibitions and participation in ca. 150 collective exhibitions.






