


Gennem godt 30 år viser vi derfor større og mindre udstillinger med exlibris fra museets samlinger, som præsenterer en bestemt kunstner eller kunstnere fra et land eller område. Ligeledes har mange udstillinger bestemte temaer eller motiver. I samarbejde med andre museer blev der skabt store udstillinger som f.eks. 'Europa og Tyren' og i de senere år har vi vist et af de mest interessante projekter, de internationale exlibris biennaler fra Polen, nærmere betegnet fra middelalderborgen Malbork.






Seit 30 Jahren zeigen wir daher in größeren und kleineren Ausstellungen Exlibris aus den Beständen des Museums, die einen Künstler oder die Künstler eines Landes vorstellen beziehungsweise bestimmte Themen und Motive. So entstanden in Zusammenarbeit mit anderen Museen große Ausstellungen wie z.B. „Europa und der Stier“. Ebenso zeigt das Museum regelmäßig die internationale Biennale des Exlibris aus Malbork in Polen.



Mit dieser neuen Reihe kleiner „Portrait“-Ausstellungen wollen wir in Zukunft Künstler der Gegenwart mit ihren Exlibris vorstellen, um die Qualität und Schönheit moderner grafisch gestalteter Bucheignerzeichen den Besuchern als Anreiz zu bieten. Hoffentlich wird sich dann der eine oder andere dazu animiert fühlen, ein eigenes Exlibris anzuschaffen.

So ist es dem Museum gelungen, eine Reihe der besten gegenwärtigen Künstler zu einer Zusammenarbeit anzuregen und dadurch diese Ausstellungsreihe ins Leben zu rufen.

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The Frederikshavn Art Museum owns one of the largest bookplate collections in the world and considers it as its obligation to familiarize the general public with graphic bookplates by regular exhibitions.

Thus, for 30 years we have shown bookplates from our funds in larger or smaller exhibitions to present one or several artists of a country, or else certain topics or motifs. In cooperation with other museums, major exhibitions like, Europe and the bull' came into being. Likewise, the museum regularly shows the exhibition of the International Biennial of the Bookplate from Malbork, Poland



In future we want to present the exlibris of contemporary artists with this new series of small 'Portrait Exhibitions' to make visitors aware of the quality, charm and beauty of the presentday graphic design of bookplates. Hopefully some will feel enticed to commission their own exlibris.

The museum succeeded in motivating a number of the best contemporary artists to cooperate and was thus able to call into life this series of exhibitions.



We introduce:

Günter Hujber

He was born in Velké Losiny, Czech Republic, on 20 May 1966. He graduated from The Technical University in Brno. During his studies there he was inspired by his colleague's paintings which started him in his first art experiments with pencil. His first pictures were mostly nudes and oil miniatures of landscapes. Further experimentation led him to add elements of dreams and symbolism into his pure nudes. His contemporary works are probably closest to symbolism in style, contrary to surrealism, given the large number of hidden symbols in the majority of his paintings.

Gunter receives his inspiration from dreams, music (from classical to heavy metal and industrial music) and literature (mainly F. Kafka, B. Hrabal and R. Bach). Apart from painting, he occasionally writes



poems and makes other projects with his friends such as recordings of short surrealistic films and improvised alternative music collages (mixtures of music, different sounds, noises, etc.). Gunter is able to produce masterpieces on oil, art graphics and combined techniques. He started to create Ex libris 2008 (till today - 2014 No. 94).

Used mediums:

1. Oil on canvas
2. Graphics + ex libris - dotted dry-point needle and relief press
3. Combined techniques - oil painting on wooden surface combined with metal fragments (aluminum and bronze)

Inspiration:

I have in my head more than 1 motive for art graphic together - it means I make together on more than 4 motives in my ideas. First idea is quickly sketched on paper and next time is created drawing, but exactly is usually made only basic motive. Lots of small details arise directly on plate during working. I usually use my special tools and some phragmets from factories to combine technique dotted dry point needle on polished and drilled copper plate, completed-finished with hammer. I love music, I almost every time during making on art graphic or painting I listen to music. It is changed by my mood and



motive in art graphic, classical music, and last time usually alternative and ambient music. It helps me to create this right atmosphere and mood for my work. Next inspiration is poems and literature. When I created collection Franz Kafka, I was completely enthralled from his works, I marked favorite part in his tales and immediately could see stories in my art graphic. I combined his tales with my life and my thinking. When I worked on collection Coursed Poets, I wrote lots of their poems, biography, lots of portraits on internet and next I combined my own portrait from their different photos and description from their characters = their portraits are combination of different photos and characters, not real and generally used portrait. Next inspiration is human body. I'm fascinated perfection and the same imperfection of human body, I love naturalness and not bodies from gym...And dream, my dreams, it is endless source of inspiration. Be-



fore sleeping I get lots ideas and I have to get up and do some description or sketch to my sketchbook. I'm short sighted, I use contact lenses and without glasses or contact lenses I can see unusual things. And thanks this handicap I don't have to use magnifying glass. I make all my art graphic without glasses or contact lenses, on very short distance. My big inspiration for my work is nature, sea-I love sea and meditation. I meditate all evening before sleep. During my holiday I collect phragments from sea, in forest. Some metal (aluminum and bronze) phragments from factories and let them inspirited me. Around us are many things, sounds for inspiration. Only to see it
