








Klemensas Kupriūnas



Frederikshavn Kunstmuseum ejer en af de største exlibrissamlinger i verden og ser det som sin opgave gennem regelmæssige udstillinger at skabe interesse for denne knap så kendte men interessante del af den grafiske kunst.



Gennem godt 30 år viser vi derfor større og mindre udstillinger med exlibris fra museets samlinger, som præsenterer en bestemt kunstner eller kunstnere fra et land eller område. Ligeledes har mange udstillinger bestemte temaer eller motiver. I samarbejde med andre museer blev der skabt store udstillinger som f.eks. 'Europa og Tyren' og i de senere år har vi vist et af de mest interessante projekter, de internationale exlibris biennaler fra Polen, nærmere betegnet fra middelalderborgen Malbork.



Med denne nye række af 'Portrait-Udstillinger' vil vi fremover præsentere exlibris af nogle af de bedste nulevende kunstnere fra mange lande, for at vise kvaliteten og skønheden i det moderne grafisk udformede bogejermærke for derigennem at skabe interesse hos museets besøgende. Måske kan den ene eller anden føle sig fristet til at anskaffe sig et exlibris.

Det er dejligt, at det er lykkedes for museet at få kontakt med nogle af nutidens bedste kunstnere og derigennem få mulighed for at gennemføre denne udstillingsrække af internationalt format.

Das Frederikshavn Kunstmuseum besitzt eine der größten Exlibris-sammlungen der Welt und sieht es als seine Aufgabe, durch regelmäßige Ausstellungen das Publikum dem grafischen Bucheignerzeichen näher zu bringen.

Seit 30 Jahren zeigen wir daher in größeren und kleineren Ausstellungen Exlibris aus den Beständen des Museums, die einen Künstler oder die Künstler eines Landes vorstellen beziehungsweise bestimmte Themen und Motive. So entstanden in Zusammenarbeit mit anderen Museen große Ausstellungen wie z.B. „Europa und der Stier“. Eben-

so zeigt das Museum regelmäßig die internationale Biennale des Exlibris aus Malbork in Polen.

Mit dieser neuen Reihe kleiner „Portrait“-Ausstellungen wollen wir in Zukunft Künstler der Gegenwart mit ihren Exlibris vorstellen, um die Qualität und Schönheit moderner grafisch gestalteter Bucheignerzeichen den Besuchern als Anreiz zu bieten. Hoffentlich wird sich dann der eine oder andere dazu animiert fühlen, ein eigenes Exlibris anzuschaffen.

So ist es dem Museum gelungen, eine Reihe der besten gegenwärtigen Künstler zu einer Zusammenarbeit anzuregen und dadurch diese Ausstellungsreihe ins Leben zu rufen.



The Frederikshavn Art Museum owns one of the largest bookplate collections in the world and considers it as its obligation to familiarize the general public with graphic bookplates by regular exhibitions.

Thus, for 30 years we have shown bookplates from our funds in larger or smaller exhibitions to present one or several artists of a country, or else certain topics or motifs. In cooperation with other museums, major exhibitions like, Europe and the bull' came into being. Likewise, the museum regularly shows the exhibition of the International Biennial of the Bookplate from Malbork, Poland

In future we want to present the exlibris of contemporary artists with this new series of small ,Portrait Exhibitions' to make visitors aware of the quality, charm and beauty of the presentday graphic design of bookplates. Hopefully some will feel enticed to commission their own exlibris.



The museum succeeded in motivating a number of the best contemporary artists to cooperate and was thus able to call into life this series of exhibitions.




Klemensas Kupriūnas

I am a painter, graphic artist, poet, sculptor, photographer, collector, journalist. I was born in 1951, in Būtėnai village, North East of Lithuania. In 1966 I went to Šiauliai, I studied in the evenings at adult secondary school and in day time at vocational school as builder.



In 1969 I stayed in Vilnius and studied at adult secondary A. Vienožinskis Art school. The basic elements of art were taught by the great artists A. Kmiliauskas, P. Rešys, M.T. Rožanskaitė, A. Pečiukonis, A. Šaltenis. In the same year I joined the technological Vilnius Technical School (*now*: Vilnius College of Technologies and Design), studied advertising-artistic photography and art. Diploma work: I illustrated the poetry by photos. Was guided by the artist R. Dichavičius.

In 1972 I held my first exhibition in Vilnius (photography, painting, sculpture) and the same year settled down in Utena town, where I live now.



In 1974 I entered to Vilnius University, Department of History, graduated in journalism studies. I worked for Utena newspaper as head of illustration department. 14 years I have been working as a chief painter in the Art Studio of Utena Culture Department.

In 1985 I created 10 sketches for granite sculpture h-170 „PAKRUOJIS. 400. Exlibris“. The artist Vincas Kisarauskas helped me spiritually and morally.

I organize and supervise the pleneres of painting, sculpture, visual poetry, graphic and international bookplate competitions. I am writing poems, reviews, illustrating books, improvise. I respect the bookplates, I love improvised jazzy-swing works.



Due to the care of the famous painter in memoriam Vincas Kisarauskas my works came to Denmark to the world-famous art collector Klaus Rödel. (Exhibition ,Dürer im Exlibris 1986-87') in Denmark, Del Bello gallery in Toronto (Canada) in 1986, 1988, exhibition ,La musique dans l'exlibris in Nancy (France) in 1988 and others.

I exhibited my works in Lithuania - Vilnius, Utena, Kupiškis, Klaipėda, Kuktiškės and others. My paintings, graphic works could be found in Belgium, Italy, France, Poland, Lavia, Estonia, Czech Republik, Bulgaria, Hungary, Norway, Sweden, Finland, Russia, USA, China, Japan and others. They are a part of national and foreign collections. National Museum of Lithuania, Vilnius University museum, M.K.Čurlionis National museum of Art, Lithuanian Medical

Library, M.Mažvydas National Library, over then 40 foreign museums and privatge collections. Nekrasov Central Universal Scientific Library in Russia, Norsk Skogfinsk Museum, Aastga Holths hjem in Norway, Frederikshavn Kunstmuseum in Denmark, Jekabpils Library and many others. They are rewarded with medals in international competitions, diplomas, prizes. I have participatged in seven Lithuanian bookplate shows, three times at the International Biennial of Vilnius bookplates.

The important assessment of my creative activity was the Art and Culture Prize of Utena town and district served in February 16th 2011.

Exlibris, the bookplate, is my favourite one in the most activities and one of the closest for me. In these little sheet that mark the books, one or another person, I am trying to render the main features of book

or library owner, sometimes to accentuate some typical characteristic or to find a laconic, simple and understandable symbol, comparison or hyperbole, that outline the character, common mood, dominating colour or human spirit of the book owner. I come over my ideas trying to render some features of character. If you look at my miniatures, you will not find there a scrupulous fiddling, detailed calculation or passive talk. All this bookplates are inspired by romantic elevation, emotion and fluency. Line, view, attributes, elements in exlibris are integrated with strong spiritual mood, particular excess of energy and feeling of space. I often draws the notes like a sketching, seldom depicting the comic situations, symbols or ironical pitch. For the most of my bookplates I do the clichés of zincography, also cut linoleum, use the etching techniques or printing by mixed techniques with different graphical materials. I have created over 4.000 bookplates. I respect the bookplate. I love improvised jazz-swing works. I always learn and have been inspired of nature, Lithuanian folklore, art and colleagues artists.

In the exhibition I am showing myself - what manner of man am I. That is the nature of art and the lookers-on are kept only to read the prints of focused serious and funny moods in these bookplates. These prints of graphic are where I printed my soul and temper.

I am a member of Lithuanian Club of Small Graphics, member of Utens Club of Writers ,Verdenė‘, the Union of Lithuanian Art Photographers.
