The Frederikshavn Art Museum owns one of the largest bookplate collections in the world and considers it as its obligation to familiarize the general public with graphic bookplates by regular exhibitions.

Thus, for 30 years we have shown bookplates from our funds in larger or smaller exhibitions to present one or several artists of a country, or else certain topics or motifs. In cooperation with other museums, major exhibitions like, Europe and the bull' came into being. Likewise, the museum regularly shows the exhibition of the International Biennial of the Bookplate from Malbork, Poland





Since 1998 he has been a member of the A.I.V. (Associazione Incisori Veneti).






### *Literary and music meetings*

Nino Baudino has a happy stroke that springs up from love and passion towards drawing, that has revealed since his childhood. During his travels he usually takes a note book, where he can note down impressions, draw events or people. Self-taught artist, pupil of



professor Enzo Chicca, a friend of Giorgio Morandi, he deepened his knowledge on engraving with professor Francesco Franco, headmaster of the Albertina Academy in Turin. Rare or depth, thick or thin lines, where the more or less stressed groove allows a range of essential, shaded off chromatic clashes, between black and white. It allows a stroke immediacy, planned and not improvised, which gives intensity and softness above all in the alternation of the different shades resulting from paintings of background. The alternation of black and white shades enlightens the scene generating different perspective observation points of the outlined scene. A lot of ex-libris deal with

classic and contemporary literature: we can find a lot of references to Odyssey, Boccaccio, Dante and to the works of Miguel de Cervantes Saavedra, Charles Dickens, Ernst Hemingway, Cesare Pavese. The ex-libris realized in 1998 for the library of Cesare Pavese Centre of Studies in Santo Stefano Belbo using two different techniques, etching and wood cut together, refers to the last work of Pavese “*La luna e I falò*”. It is a wonderful homage to Cesare Pavese and it is a love act towards his native country, Piemonte region; in fact Nino Baudino was born in Cuneo in 1951. Contrasts between white and black in the engraving, skilfully describe villages, hills, places where tales were set; wood cut with his tilting stroke, his close surfaces and the red ink of the print enclose the tragic event and the final, linked to events and cruelties of the civil war, which gives the title to the work. The literary moment with reference to the music in the ex libris dedicated to his son, Andrea Baudino, shows us one of the five Dickens’ Christmas carols “*Christmas Carol*” dated 1843. Christmas is a magic moment that sweetens the ice cold aim of Scrooge; Baudino in his work shows us Scrooge’s shoulders, while he is bringing his left hand next to the window. A black mark that mixes up together with the window’s structure, a black that Christmas will modify up to change Scrooge in new man. We can breath this Christmas atmosphere from serenity, happy and relaxed faces of the three characters on the road; they take part with music and carols to this joyful moment. Instruments, notes and music scores are present in a lot of ex libris; they produce an exciting moment, a chance to look at our personal relationship with the music again, to recall some important events of our life related to music. And now the boat that wanders, sails are completely spread, tight from wind, without any destination, without any stop, flying on the waves of a dark and storming see, as lost souls. We are fascinated by this boat which wanders, “*Der fliegende Holländer*” drawn from a book of Heine, work that Richard Wagner realized in 1841, inspired from the wild spectacle of the storm that surprised him next to the Norwegian shores while he was travelling to London. Baudino shows us also a lot of instruments with a deep mastery and connection to reality; the most important example is the summary between instrument and surrounding space as in the ex libris dedicated to





Floriana Rapastelli, which describes the organ in Orvieto Cathedral. Sometimes Floriana's father has played this organ, so the drawing shares with us emotions and enthusiasm coming from the organ's impulse and from the majestic architecture of the Cathedral. In Nino Baudino's ex libris the graphic image is almost a text, a ledger; the book of life is in front of us and in this way the ex libris, dedicated graphic, becomes a love act for the book which is the cradle of our roots and contemporary a union and cohesion element amongst people thanks to literary and musical expressions.

***Incontri letterari e musicali***

Nino Baudino ha un tratto felice che nasce dall'amore e dalla passione per il disegno, fin dall'infanzia; è sua abitudine tenere con se, viaggiando, un quaderno da disegno ove annotare impressioni, disegnare eventi, persone; autodidatta, allievo del professor Enzo Chicca, amico di Giorgio Morandi, ha approfondito i suoi studi sulla calcografia con il professor Francesco Franco, direttore dell'Accademia Albertina di Torino. Gli ex libris incisi dal 1987 narrano ed illustrano principalmente il mondo della letteratura, della musica e della natura, la montagna in particolare. Tratti radi o fitti, fini o spessi, ove il solco più o meno accentuato permette una gamma di contrasti cromatici essenziali, sfumati, tra il bianco ed il nero, manifestano una immediatezza del segno, meditato, non improvvisato, che dà intensità e morbidezza soprattutto nell'alternanza delle differenti tonalità risultanti nelle campiture. L'alternanza dei bianchi e dei neri illumina la scena creando differenti punti di osservazione prospettica della scena delineata. Numerosi ex libris trattano la letteratura classica e la contemporanea: i riferimenti all'Odissea, a Boccaccio, Dante, e ai testi di Miguel de Cervantes Saavedra, Charles Dickens, Ernst Hemingway, Cesare Pavese. L'ex libris per la Biblioteca del Centro Studi Cesare Pavese di Santo Stefano Belbo (1998), che si avvale sia dell'acquaforte e della xilografia su legno di filo, si richiama a "La luna e i falò", l'ultima opera di Cesare Pavese, mirabile tributo di Nino Baudino a Cesare Pavese e segno di amore alla sua regione natale, il Piemonte, Baudino è nato infatti a Cuneo nel 1951. I contrasti del bianco e nero della calcografia descrivono in modo magistrale le colline, i luoghi dei fatti narrati, mentre la xilografia, nei tratti inclinati e nelle superfici compatte, e l'inchiostro rosso della stampa racchiudono l'evento tragico, ed il finale, legato alle vicende ed efferatezze della guerra civile, che dà il titolo al libro. Il momento letterario con riferimenti alla musica, nell'ex libris dedicato a suo figlio Andrea, illustrano uno dei cinque racconti dedicati da Charles Dickens al tema natalizio, "Un Canto di Natale" del 1843. Il Natale è il momento magico che schiude l'animo gelido di Scrooge che vediamo di spalle mentre avvicina la mano si-

nistra alla finestra. Un segno nero che si confonde con la struttura della stessa finestra, un nero che il Natale modificherà fino a far diventare Scrooge un uomo nuovo. E' presente un'atmosfera natalizia che si evince dai volti dei tre personaggi che sono nella strada e che parteci-

pano e contribuiscono chi con la musica chi con i canti a questa grande festa. Strumenti, note e spartiti musicali animano molti ex libris creando un momento di stimolo, un'occasione per riesaminare il proprio personale rapporto con la musica per rievocare qualche episodio della propria vita ove la musica ha coronato un momento che di certo non manca nel vissuto di tutti noi. Ecco il vascello con le vele completamente spiegate, tese dal vento, senza meta, senza mai fermarsi, che vola sulle onde di un mare scuro e tempestoso, siamo affascinati da questa nave che vaga, "L'Olandese Volante", tratto da un libro di Heine, l'opera di Richard Wagner (1841), ispirata dallo spettacolo selvaggio della tempesta che lo colse presso le coste norvegesi nel viaggio verso Londra. Tra i numerosi strumenti raffigurati, con profonda maestria e attinenza alla realtà, esemplare la sintesi tra strumento e spazio contenitore come si evince dall'ex libris eseguito per Floriana Rapastelli che descrive l'organo del Duomo di Orvieto, suonato in alcune occasioni dal padre della titolare, il disegno ci fa partecipi dell'emozione e del trasporto che deriva dallo slancio dell'organo che dalla maestosità architettura del Duomo. Negli ex libris di Nino Baudino l'immagine grafica costituisce quasi un testo, un libro mastro; il libro della vita è di fronte a noi e in questo modo l'ex libris, grafica dedicata, diviene un atto d'amore per il libro che diviene culla delle nostre radici e contemporaneamente un elemento di unione e coesione tra gli uomini grazie alle espressioni letterarie e musicali.
